How Can We Help You?

In partnership with the Adams County (AC) Small Business Initiative, the North Metro Small Business Development Center (SBDC) at Front Range Community College is providing the *Jump Start Program* this spring. This program is an opportunity for residents of Adams County to gain self-employment through training and support in business concepts which focus on starting or growing an existing business. The goal of the program is to help participants complete a business plan or feasibility study in 8 weeks.

The *Jump Start Program* will help you quickly develop your business plan and determine the feasibility of launching your business. Each course will consist of 12 hours of training and requires each participant to schedule 3 hours of free, one-on-one counseling with an SBDC counselor. Classes meet every other week to allow participants time to complete assignment and meet with their counselors. Courses will be offered in Commerce City, Brighton, Westminster, and Unincorporated Adams County.

Adams County Small Business Initiative's Mission:

To empower people of low to moderate income to become self-sufficient. This will be accomplished by providing small businesses with high quality, cost effective assistance through consulting, training, and partnering with resource providers. A positive economic impact will be fostered by the successful growth and development of these small businesses.
