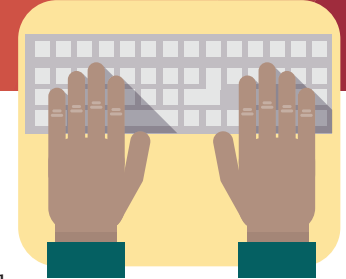

BUSINESS PLANS HANDBOOK

provides actual business plans from businesses in the manufacturing, retail, and service industries which serve as examples of how to approach, structure, and compose business plans. Start your search by a basic keyword search.

BUSINESS SOURCE PREMIER

provides full-text access to thousands of business journals, including popular and academic business publications. Coverage includes all subject areas related to business, including accounting, management, finances, personnel, and more; also includes access to MarketLine industry reports.

DEMOGRAPHICS NOW

provides detailed U.S. demographic data, with reporting and mapping capabilities. Good for business, sociology, finance, marketing, public administration, political science research and for preparing a business plan, comparing macro and micro trends of a selected populations, comparing the demographics and market potential of any geography(ies) in the United States.

FIRST RESEARCH

provides unlimited access to online profiles on over 900 industries, including industry overviews, competitive landscape, products and product niches, operations and technology, sales and marketing, finance, regulations, regional and international issues, human resources and labor standards, financial ratios and cost structure benchmarks. LEGAL INFORMATION REFERENCE CENTER

provides full-text publications and thousands of legal forms. The full-text legal reference books are provided through Nolo, the nation’s oldest and most-respected provider of legal information for consumers and small businesses.

MERGENT INTELLECT

provides detailed information on over 80 million U.S. private and public businesses, 245 million global private businesses, including sales volume, number of employees and more; over 90 million executives including contacts and biographies. Download 2,000 records at one time. (Dun & Bradstreet/Hoovers product)

REFERENCE USA

provides detailed information on 50 million public and private U.S. businesses, and 300 million residents. Good for searching your business competitors, for B2B or B2C prospect lists, and locating your potential customers (Lifestyle module).

STATISTA

provides multi-disciplinary statistics, facts, and market data covering various markets and industries. Available in multiple languages. Due to licensing restrictions, this site is not available for at-home use.
