

Establish a Professional Domain, Website, & Email for Your Business

A domain name is your address on the web.
It's how people can visit your website.

A **domain name** comes after “[www.](#)” in a web address and after the “[@](#)” in an email address.

A **URL** is a complete web address, including the domain name, used to access a web page. Example:

[www.stasiabakery.com/index.html](#)

A **website** holds the content people see and interact with when they visit pages associated with a domain name.

- Visit [domains.google](#).
- Enter the domain you want.
- Click [Get It](#) to see availability.

Tips for Choosing a Domain

- Keep it short and simple.
- Use keywords and brand terms.
- Consider alternative endings.

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Included with Google Domains: Email Forwarding

Email forwarding allows you to set up aliases, alternative addresses that forward email to actual email addresses.

- From [Google Domains](#), click [Manage](#), then Email.
 - Under [Email forwarding](#), click [Add email alias](#).
 - Enter an email alias and the recipient email address.
